FaithLife Ministries Celebrates its 21st Anniversary!

January 22nd was our 21st anniversary! We began this ministry on that date in 2001 and we are so thankful to God for all that HE has produced through this ministry.

Since our beginning we have trained over 60,000 pastors, church leaders and Bible students in 104 nations with our Management for Church LeadersTM and Discipleship for Church LeadersTM training. We have established a global trainer network that now has 84 trainers in 48 nations. And our training has also been translated into 27 languages.

We are also thankful for our many donors and supporters that have prayed for us and supported us financially to accomplish what God has done through all of us.

To God alone belongs the glory!! We are only His instruments to accomplish His purposes.

FaithLife Ministries 2022 Ministry Plans



At our last board meeting in November, we approved our strategic plan and budget for 2022. Here are some of the goals we have set forth for this ministry next year:

- 1. Establish active global trainers in 6 more nations
- 2. Add 4 new MCL Trainers to our global network
- 3. Train 6,000 pastors and church leaders
- 4. Reach 2 new nations with our MCL training
- 5. Develop new training resources

God has given us our direction and goals for 2022, and our focus is to do our best to achieve them according to His will and plan. We are here simply to be obedient and trusting in His purpose & plan!

Global Training Summary



Our network trained a total of 5,752 pastors and leaders in 2021. This was very close to our goal of 6,000 for the year! They conducted a total of 117 conferences in 2021, a wonderful achievement considering the existence of restrictions in many nations from the Covid virus.

Even better than that, global restrictions seem to be easing now. As a result, our global trainer network has already conducted 26 training conferences in January & February of this year! They have trained a total of 1,051 pastors and leaders in these conferences in 13 different nations, including Kenya, Uganda, Burundi (see photo above), Ghana, Nigeria, Liberia, Cameroon, Tanzania, India, Myanmar, Nepal, Jamaica, and Peru. There are already an additional 26 conferences planned for March and April as well. So, we are off to a great start in 2022!

We also added 3 new global trainers to our network in the past three months. They are Pastor Japheth Eroman in Benin City, Nigeria, Dr. Theophilus Bekoe in Accra, Ghana, and Pastor Ed Udell in College Station, TX in the USA. This brings our total number of global trainers to 84 in 49 nations!

We are also hoping to add 3 more global trainers soon. This will add two more nations that will now have an active MCL trainer - **Papua New Guinea** and **Senegal!** This will bring our total of nations with active Trainers to 36!

Due to my travel restrictions, our global trainer network has become the primary vehicle for training pastors and church leaders around the world. We are so thankful to God for these trainers and the efforts they put forth on behalf of this ministry. To God alone be the glory!

Meet Our Newest MCL Trainers

We added two new global MCL Trainers in February. Meet the newest members of our global trainer network:

Dr. Theophilus Bekoe



Dr. Theophilus Bekoe is from Accra, Ghana, and attended my training there in 2011. He reconnected with us about 4 years ago and has taught our MCL & DCL since then. Recently I encouraged him to join our network of trainers and to officially become part of what we are doing. He gladly accepted and has already conducted a training earlier this month.

Pastor Ed Udell pastors a church in College Station, TX in the USA. He found us on the internet last year and was interested in our training material. He also has contacts in Uganda & Kenya whom he wanted to help. He has gone through our MCL Self-Training Book and hopes to do training both in his church and community as well as Uganda and other parts of Africa. He hopes to start training soon.

We thank the Lord for bringing these two men to serve alongside of us in training pastors and church leaders!

Believe the Unbelievable!



"The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us."

John 1:14

Many people use the word 'unbelievable' to describe something amazing that happened or that they witnessed. In my opinion, most people mean incredible instead of unbelievable, as whatever happened was actually quite believable.

For example, years ago, Pittsburgh Steelers running back Franco Harris made an amazing catch during an NFL playoff game, now known as the "immaculate reception". A forward pass took an unusual bounce off the intended receiver, and he caught the ball before it hit the ground and ran for a touchdown to help the Steelers win the game.

That catch was incredible, but not unbelievable, because we all saw it and knew that it was possible, though quite improbable. The fact that the ball bounced in his direction was not a miracle, nor was it hard to believe given the nature of sports and all the crazy things that happen. It happened because of the unique circumstances brought about by natural causes (a pass, a bounce off one player, and a catch by another player running nearby).

I don't use the word unbelievable very often because most things that happen are not miracles or incredible enough to warrant that description.

But there was one event in history that was *unbelievable* - the birth of Jesus Christ, the savior of the world! His birth was brought about by an act of God who wanted His Son to become a man, to live among us and to eventually die for us. The physical birth was a miracle. It was so hard to believe that many people of that time rejected Him and would not believe in Him (**Luke 4:24-30**). Sadly, the same is true of many people today.

But to those who are willing to believe the unbelievable, they shall be saved and live eternally with God their Creator (John 3:16). We do not deserve it, nor can we earn it. It's God's free gift to us if we simply believe and put our faith in Jesus, the baby born of God in Bethlehem! Isn't that the message we want to share this Christmas with everyone?

I believe it is!


Resource Development
