Management for Church Leaders Online Video Training Launched!



We are pleased to announce that our **Management For Church Leaders**TM training course is now available to take online via video! This course is FREE but requires registration to access the course videos.

This course was initially developed in 2001 and has reached 121 nations since it was first taught in 2002. Over 70,000 pastors and church leaders have been trained in that time through our personal training, our 88 member global trainer network, and our self-training book!

We are thankful to God to be able to add this new training format to our training curriculum for those who prefer to take our course online and at their own pace and convenience.

Training Firsts!



We are also excited to announce several firsts for our ministry.

At the end of March, we had our first ever MCL training in the United States! There was a pastor in Churchville, NY, Nathan Gautam, who requested our MCL Self-Training Book a few months ago and proceeded to teach it to his 13 church leaders. He ministers to a community of Nepali people.

In early April, we had the first ever training in **Senegal** by our new MCL Trainer there, **Thomas Mendy.**

Also in early April we had the first ever in person training of our MCL in **Taiwan** by a local pastor, **Juara Alado**, who had also previously requested our MCL Self-Training Book. I am hoping to add Nathan and Juara to our global trainer network!

We continue to be amazed at how God works through our ministry to spread His teaching!

Global Training Summary

The past three months have seen a tremendous growth in the training of pastors and church leaders by our global trainer network. Here are the summaries for each of the past 3 months:

In March, our global trainer network conducted

9 Management for Church Leaders training conferences. Those conferences were held in Kenya, Uganda, Tanzania, Liberia, Argentina, and Bangladesh. We also had our first ever MCL training in the USA by a pastor who is not



part of our global trainer network! In March a total of 509 pastors and church leaders were trained (*The photo here is from a training in Satkhira, Bangladesh by Pastor Swadhin Biswas.*)



Our global trainers were very active in the month of April conducting 20 training conferences in 12 nations including Uganda, Kenya, Burundi, the DRC, Senegal, Liberia, Cameroon, Ghana, Mala-

wi, Nepal, Taiwan, and France. Our global trainers trained a total of 1,060 pastors and church leaders! Two of the conferences taught our MCL #2 training. (The photo here is from a training April 1-4 in Thies, Senegal by Thomas Mendy. It was his first MCL training as a member of our global trainer network!)

There were 13 training conferences scheduled in May in

the nations of Egypt, France, Bangladesh, Kenya, Uganda, Tanzania, Cameroon and India. (The photo here is from the training in Mleba Bukoba, Tanzania by Pastor Hassan Rangi.) Ten of them have been completed with 3 others to be conducted this week and next. Through these 10 conferences, 321 pastors and church leaders were trained on



our Management for Church Leaders training.

Thus far in 2023 our network has trained a total of 3,191 pastors, church leaders, and Bible students via 72 conferences in 23 nations! God is on the move, Hallelujah!

Leadership International Partnership



I recently met with Caleb Davison and Josh Warren with Leadership International when they were here in Atlanta. Caleb is their International Director and Josh is their Director of Engagement. We discussed their use of our training manuals in their curriculum for their African and Asian Bible training centers. They currently use our translated MCL & DCL manuals and sometimes translate that training into the languages that they need which they then provide to us. They provide the training to their network of trainers, and I assist them on how to teach our training. They are also interested in using the video training of our courses when they are completed as well. We have also referred them to our contacts in Latin America to help them in their global expansion in that region.

Our Newest MCL Trainer



We are excited to announce the addition of another MCL global trainer in India. His name Dr. **Bankit** Marpna and he is a Bible College professor in the city **Shillong** of in Northeast India. Dr. Marpna was referred ministry

through another MCL trainer in Northeast India, Pastor Amos Humtsoe, who joined our global trainer network in 2021. After visiting our website, he registered to take our MCL video training course online. He completed the online course and then requested to join our global trainer network!

Our Strategic Partnerships

"Two are better than one, because they have a good return for their work." - Ecclesiastes 4:9

Over the past several years we have been developing several important strategic partnerships for this ministry. These are intended to extend our training to nations and locations where our training might be helpful, and where we either have no presence or a limited ability to enter these nations on our own.

One of our strategic partners is **Leadership International** out of Nashville, TN. They establish Bible training centers in Africa and Asia and provide curriculum for their global network of trainers. Our MCL & DCL courses are part of that curriculum (*see article on page 2*). This partnership enables us to train more pastors and church leaders with our training throughout Asia and Africa, multiplying our reach there.

A second strategic partner that we have is **China Partner**. They are a ministry based in Denver, CO that has a network of registered churches and seminaries throughout China. I had planned to travel with them to introduce our training to their network until Covid prevented that. So, I have recorded our MCL #1 training and am now recording our MCL #2 training for them with a Chinese translator on Zoom. They then make those recordings available to their network in a secure fashion to avoid government interference. While China may be only one country, it has about 1.5 billion people, of which about 100 million are estimated to be Christians. This partnership enables us to provide our training in China and expand our global reach throughout this nation.

A third strategic partner we are working with is the **Middle East Leadership Training Institute**, or **MELTI**. This is a Cairo based ministry led by **Dr. Wahid Wahba**, one of our board of directors. They provide a wide variety of training throughout the Middle East which now includes our MCL training. They have the ability to take our training into nations that we cannot access on our own and in a manner that is far more effective. Again, this enables us to expand our training into nations that are hard to access and that can also benefit from our training.

We have also developed partnerships with two online Bible Schools who provide our training on video. Lucent University (global) has included our MCL training in their degree programs since 2021 and Leader Formation Insitute (Europe) will be adding our MCL training on video for their students later this year. Our MCL & DCL training manuals are also provided as a resource through GPRO, a global pastoral training ministry.

Training in Nations Hostile to Christianity

Open Doors (www.opendoors.org) is a ministry that annually publishes a list of nations where there is a high level of Christian persecution. They call it the **World Watch List** and it shows the top 50 nations where Christians are being most persecuted.

I have taught our Management for Church Leaders training in 13 of these 50 nations, among them were the nations of Nigeria, India, Myanmar, China, Egypt and the Democratic Republic of Congo. I did not experience persecution in these nations myself when I was there, but I was still uncomfortable in those environments. And today, the situation has gotten much worse in nations like the DRC, Myanmar and India where the persecution has escalated even more for political reasons.

We also have global trainers who have taught our MCL in 22 of the 50 nations, and some of them continue to do so even today. They often face many dangers in taking our training to these nations as well as the nations of **Sudan, Bangladesh**, and **Cuba**. I am humbled and grateful for their willingness and sacrifice to do so.

The world does not always welcome the message of the gospel and the truth of the Bible. But we can't back down and we must continue to do what God has called us to do. We should follow Paul's instruction to Timothy when he said, "But you, keep your head in all situations, endure hardship, do the work of an evangelist, discharge all the duties of your ministry." (2 Timothy 4:5)

Please pray for this ministry and for our global trainers who do this training on our behalf and at great personal risk, sacrifice, and cost.

- We have added 2 new MCL Trainers to our global trainer network. They are Pastor Peter Kangara from Dar es Salaam, Tanzania and Dr. Bankit Marpna from Shillong, India.
- We began recording our MCL #2 training with a Chinese translator in March for China Partner. We have recorded 6 chapters so far and will complete all 12 by August.
- We have completed all of the training videos of our MCL #1 and have provided them to **Leader Formation Institute** in **Romania** for their online Bible School. This course will begin in August after they add Romanian subtitle translations to the videos.
