Scattering the Seed



"Still other seed fell on good soil, where it produced a crop - a hundred, sixty or thirty times what was sown."

Matthew 13:8

Our mission and goal as a ministry has been to spread our training to as many nations as possible that want or need it. We discovered early on that our **Management for Church Leaders**TM training was indeed valuable and needed throughout the world. It was like the seed Jesus describes in His **Parable of the Sower** in **Matthew 13:1-9 & 18-23**. We are the farmer in the parable who simply scatters the seed that was provided by God. While we may have developed the training, it was truly God who wrote it because it comes from His Word. So we did not create the seed nor did we control the type of soil that it fell upon. We simply scattered the seed and waited upon the Lord to produce the crop that would come when it was sown in nations where the "soil was fertile."

In the past 17 years we have seen which nations had fertile soil where we have planted the seed of our training. Our global trainer network testifies to those nations that were fertile. These are nations where the Lord has not only produced a large crop, but where He raised up trainers who continue to produce an ever increasing crop through the re-planting of our training in their nations and others!

We are grateful to God for being called by Him to scatter the seed of this training. And we are thankful for our global trainer network that continues to scatter the seed along with us. It is a privilege to be His instrument in serving the training needs of His Church around the world!



Annual Fundraising Appeal is in the Mail

We mailed out our annual fundraising letter for 2018 in late June. As most of you know, we only ask for funds one time every year, usually around the 1st of July (for those of you who give at the end of the year we send out the annual letter in late November). We do not offer incentives or gifts for donations but rather simply pray for God to move in the hearts of those who receive our mailing to respond according to His Spirit and guidance. First Ever Guinea Bissau Training!

Bishop Sameul Bobor from **Sierra Leone** recently took our MCL training to the nation of **Guinea Bissau** in western



Africa (see photo). The training was held **August** 15-19th in the city of **Bissau** and he trained 250 pastors and church leaders. This was the first ever training there and is the 79th nation to receive our MCL training!! Bishop Bobor has

been an MCL Trainer since 2014 and has not only taught our MCL training in his home country of Sierra Leone, but has also taken our training to the nations of **Guinea** and **Gambia** in West Africa.

Also of note is that I have never met Bishop Bobor. He requested and received our training materials via email in 2012 and he immediately taught our material to a group of 100 pastors & leaders in Freetown, the capital of Sierra Leone, in December of that year. He has since been a reliable, consistent and effective trainer for us and a valuable member of our Global Trainer Network!

We have now reached 39 of the 42 nations in Africa that we set out to reach! The 3 remaining nations are **Angola**, **Namibia** and **Madagascar**, all in southern Africa.

Have Training...Will Travel!

Our Management for Church Leaders TM (MCL) training schedule for this year has been updated to include a new

training trip to the **Ukraine** in November. Gary Church and I will return to the **Tavriski Christian Institute** in Kherson November 12-15th to teach the MCL #2 training and a seminar on fundraising. Our **China** training trip, which had



been planned for October this year, had to be postponed due to the current religious and political climate in China at the moment. Hopefully we will be able to reschedule that trip in the future.

We would also like to announce some of our training trip plans for 2019. We are planning a trip to **Albania**, **Macedonia** and **Greece** in January. We have also agreed to return to **Grenada** in April of 2019 to teach our MCL #2 training and to go to **Kyrgyzstan** in June of 2019 to teach our first ever MCL training in that nation. We are also discussing possible training in **Lebanon**, **Armenia**, **India** and **Peru**. We will prioritize all of our training trips subject to our vision, strategy and available resources.

Global Trainer Multiplication!

We were excited to learn recently that one of our global trainers, **Pastor Wilson Esambe** from **Cameroon**, has raised up another trainer in **Liberia** to teach our **Management for Church Leaders** TM training there! Pastor

Esambe traveled to Liberia in April to introduce our training to his friend and colleague, **Pastor Rufus Kahn** (see photo). Pastor Kahn is the **National Leader of the Free Methodist Church in Liberia** and oversees 14 churches



and 11 church plants in several locations. Pastor Kahn emailed me last week and said "I am deeply grateful to you for your teaching material: Management for Church Leaders. Thank you so much for enhancing my work through these materials." We are thrilled to see those we train go out and train others who go out and train others! (Pastor Kahn is not the first "2nd generation" trainer for us as there have been others in Uganda & Kenya).

It also turns out that Pastor Kahn knows our Gobal MCL Trainer in Liberia, **Pastor Moses Wheigar.** So we look forward to the two of them raising up more leaders for the Church in Liberia in the years to come. We praise and thank God for what He is doing in our midst!



Here are some FaithLife facts you might not know:

- Barry has been on 125 mission trips, Kim 28.
- Barry has taught in 44 different nations, Kim 10.
- Barry & Kim have taught together on 21 trips in 9 nations
- Barry has made 23 mission trips by himself.
- Our most visited nation has been the Philippines with 19 trips there, followed by Peru with 15 trips and Kazakhstan with 13 trips.
- Barry has never met 13 of our 64 global trainers in person
- Our Management for Church Leaders Volume #1 training has been translated into 23 languages!
- We have sent out 163 copies of our MCL selftraining book to 50 countries, including 22 copies within the USA.
- Our MCL Training has been taught to 39,499 pastors and leaders worldwide. Barry has personally taught 6,637 of them.
- We have 475 recipients of our newsletter and 919 followers on our ministry Facebook page.

Global MCL Training

As is typical, training tends to slow down in the summer months of June & July. I'm not sure why that is but it has been the pattern for the past several years. But there are some highlights:



1. **Pastor Gideon Nair**, our primary MCL Trainer in **India**, took our training to **Jammu July 13-14th**, which is in the northwest part of India. The trip took several days by train and bus but the response

and participation were worth it (*see photo*). He trained 26 pastors and church leaders. Please read his profile below.

- 2. **Pastor Gordon Onyango**, an MCL Trainer in **Kenya**, conducted an MCL training in **Narok June 5-7th** where he trained 197 leaders of which 144 were pastors! Gordon has trained 673 leaders in total this year!
- 3. **Dr. Theophilus Bekoe**, who is not yet a member of our network, conducted 2 trainings in June of our **Discipleship** for **Church Leaders** training in **Ghana** in the towns of **Okajakram** and **Atwima Min**. He trained a total of 40 pastors and church leaders.
- 4. **Pastor James Ochwo**, our primary MCL Trainer in **Uganda**, trained 138 pastors and church leaders on our MCL training in the city of **Kyankwanzi July 4-6th**. Please read his profile below.

MCL Trainer - Pastor James Ochwo

I first met **James Ochwo** in **Kampala**, **Uganda** at a training conference we held there in 2009. He was one of over 150 attendees but I remembered him in particular. A few years later I learned that he was using our materials to train others in Uganda on his own. So in 2014 I invited him to join our



global trainer network that we had just established. He readily said yes! In 2015, James hosted a conference of MCL Trainers from East Africa for us in Kampala. The purpose was to provide "train the trainer" type training to our MCL Trainers in the region. James also invited 8 other potential trainers in Uganda to attend

whom we also trained. They all joined our network, including a pastor from **Tanzania** and another from the **Congo.**

Since then James has been our primary MCL Trainer in Uganda and coordinates all of our training and trainers there. He has trained 2,320 pastors and leaders via 25 training conferences since 2013. He is a pastor and the Director & Founder of **Kingdom Life International Ministries**, a church leadership training ministry. He is married and has 6 children and lives in Kampala, Uganda.

Who Do You Say That I Am?

This famous question was asked by Jesus of his disciples in **Matthew 16:15**. Peter's answer, of course, was that Jesus was Christ, the Son of the living God. Well, I'm not Jesus but yet my identity has also come into question. I was recently contacted by **Western Union** to explain the nature of a recent money transfer I had sent to our MCL Trainer in **Pakistan** to help with the cost of him conducting 6 training conferences of our material. Despite my supplying information about who we are and what we do as a ministry, Western Union has denied my use of their services. They would not give me a reason due to their security policy.

The only explanation I can come up with is that they are suspicious of my transactions to nations with terrorist activities, such as Pakistan, Nigeria, and South Sudan. I can appreciate that and I guess they did not accept my explanation of what we do and all of the information about our ministry I sent to them. One of the key reasons may be that I have not personally met our contact in Pakistan, and they see that as a huge red flag. Our government is very serious about trying to stop money laundering and unfortunately to some it may look like that is what we are doing.

Although we have been open about our ministry and our global activities Western Union is still suspicious of our motives. But God knows who I am and you know who I am and what we do. And that's all that matters to me! So I have had to suspend funding any global training for now. And though I can't send money via Western Union anymore, I know God will make a way for our global training to continue!

MCL Trainer - Pastor Gideon Nair

Pastor Gideon Nair is one of our dearest friends and a long time MCL Trainer from **Bangalore**, **India**. I met Gideon in

2003 on my first trip to India to do some training with one of our church's mission partners there, **United Evangelical Mission India**. Gideon worked for that ministry before branching out on his own in 2005 and forming **Help India International Mission**. In 2010 he invited me to come and train in the part of India where he does his minis-



try, the state of Odisha where he is originally from. We trained together there in the city of **Korba** in October of 2013.

Gideon joined our Global Trainer Network in 2014 and has been taking our MCL training to different parts of his nation ever since. He even changed the name of his ministry to Faith Life Ministries India in 2015. He also accompanied me to the Global Proclamation Congress for Pastoral Trainers in Bangkok, Thailand in June, 2016 where we did a joint presentation on our training strategy. He is also our coordinator of MCL training for India. Gideon is married and has two children and lives in Bangalore, India.


