Pakistan Training Continues!

Despite the death in May of **Dr. Muqaddam Zia**, our MCL Trainer in **Pakistan**, and the cancellation by Western Union in June of our use of their service to send funds due



to a previous transaction to Pakistan, God has enabled us to continue the training and our funding of it in this Islamic nation! The photo here is from a train-

ing that was held in September in the city of Okara. The training was taught by Muqaddar Johnson (on the far left in the photo), brother of Dr. Muqaddam Zia, and the Mission Director for Pakistan Outreach, the ministry that Dr. Zia ran and conducted our training through the past few years.


Muqaddar has taught our material in the past along with Muqaddam and we are so grateful to God that he has decided to continue the training on our behalf. We were also able to work out an alternative way to send funds to him that went through even after the new service called me to conduct a security check on the transaction. God answered our prayer and we are able to resume our training through Muqaddar in Pakistan. Muqaddar has one more training this week in the town of **Sahiwal** and may have a few more in the months ahead.

We thank God for His provision of a new means of sending funds to Pakistan and for Muqaddar, His servant!! Please pray for him and these dear Christian pastors & leaders in Pakistan.

FaithLife Reaches New Training Milestone!

We recently sent out the **200th** copy of our **Management for Church Leaders Training Book!** This is

our self-training manual that anyone can request from our website. Since we began making our self-training manual available in 2014 on our website we have sent copies to 205



recipients in 50 nations. We have received the most requests from Nigeria with 30 being sent, followed by the USA with 26 and South Africa with 20. There are 9 nations where this Training Book was our initial entry for our training into that nation. They include Canada, El Salvador, Haiti, Jamaica, Papua New Guinea, South Sudan, Sri Lanka, Swaziland, and Vanuatu.

We have also sent copies to 11 nations that we have yet to reach. I am following up with each contact to determine if they have gone through the entire manual. If so, our training would be deemed to have reached that nation. These nations include Armenia, Australia, Brunei, Egypt, England, Hungary, Kuwait, Lebanon, Lithuania, Taiwan and the United Arab Emirates.

We praise God for making this possible and look forward to reaching more nations with our training in this way in the future!

Ukraine MCL #2 Training Report

Barry & Gary Church traveled to Kherson, Ukraine from November 8th to 17th to train students at the Tavriski Christian Institute (TCI) on our Manage-



ment for Church Leaders Volume #2 training. We trained a total of 8 leaders (of which 3 were pastors) over 3 days as part of their Christian Leader-

ship degree program. (Last year Gary and I were at the TCI and trained on our MCL volume #1 manual to several of these same students.) We had great participation as all of the students were studying to enhance their current church ministry work. Barry also provided our training on the subject of Fundraising to the TCI staff of 12 leaders. TCI is also coordinating a training for Barry next June at the Silk Road Bible College in the city of Bishkek, Kyrgyzstan. He will be training about 20 students on both our MCL #1 and MCL #2 manuals. We are thankful to God for connecting us to this ministry and the opportunity to train church leaders and pastors in these nations!

Ministry Update at First Lutheran Church in El Cajon, CA

Barry and Kim traveled to El, Cajon CA for Barry to give a ministry update presentation to First Luther-

an Church on Sunday, September 16th, one of our long time church supporters. In two worship services (see photo) Barry shared about the growth of our Global Trainer Network, the rapid increase in the number of pastors and leaders we have trained the past few years, and reaching 80 nations with our training thus far. Barry also taught



their adult Sunday School class on the fact that all Christians are called to be Ministers (1 Peter 4:10) and Missionaries (2 Corinthians 5:20). We also met their new pastor for the first time, Pastor Andrew Fedder, and renewed old friendships from previous mission trips we did together.

3 More Nations Reached With Our Training!




Our Management for Church Leaders training has reached 3 more new nations this month! Earlier this month an MCL Training Book recipient in Vanuatu, a island nation in the South Pacific, informed me that he had completed going through our training. He is also

planning to train others in his nation and will likely join our Global Trainer Network as well! Last week, **Pastor Wilson Esambe** from **Cameroon** took our MCL training to the African island nation of **Sao Tome**, the first time it has been taught there. And this week, **Dr. Martin Baboka** from the **Ivory Coast** is currently in **Angola** teaching our MCL training there for the first time. That brings our total of nations reached to <u>83!</u> We praise and thank God for these nations that now have our training and pray that it will continue to spread where it is needed!

In August we reached our 80th nation for our training. We have since reached 3 more new nations as indicated in the story to the left bringing our current total to **83**!



Global MCL Training

In September, October and November there were 37 MCL



training conferences held by our global network trainers in the nations of Kenya, Uganda, Pakistan, Nepal, Ghana, Myanmar, Togo, Tanzania, Sao Tome, Angola, the DRC and India. Thus far they report having trained 1,847 pastors and church leaders. Here are a few highlights:

- 1. **Pastor Gordon Onyango** trained 158 pastors and leaders in **Maralal, Kenya**.
- 2. **Pastor James Ochwo** trained 123 pastors and church leaders in **Kanungu**, **Uganda** and another 87 in **Amuru**.
- 3. **Pastor Rajendra Sundas** trained 30 pastors and leaders in the district of **Sindhuli**, **Nepal** and another 50 in **Dhashing Besi**.
- 4. **Pastor Steve Obonyo** from **Kenya** conducted 2 trainings, one in **Longinyani** and another in **Maralal**, where he trained a total of 64 pastors and church leaders.
- 5. Muqaddar Johnson trained 21 pastors and leaders in the town of Okara, Pakistan and another 23 in Sahiwal.
- 6. **Pastor Chin Mung** is training 65 Bible students in **Yangon**, **Myanmar**.

MCL Trainer - Pastor Wilson Esambe

Pastor Wilson Esambe is our MCL Trainer in **Cameroon**. He is the **National Leader** of the **Free Methodist Church** in Cameroon and also pastors City of God Mission church in

Douola. He first contacted us through our website back in 2013 and I sent him our training materials. He immediately began to teach our training and sent me a testimony about the impact it was having. He continued to train our MCL on his own and had it translated into French for us as well! Pastor



Esambe joined our Global Trainer Network in March of 2014 and has been one of our most consistent trainers.

I met Wilson at an MCL training we held in Lagos, Nigeria in 2014 that I had invited him to attend. I also asked him to teach one of the chapters so I could evaluate his teaching ability. He proved to be an excellent trainer! Since then he has continued to train others in Cameroon, as well as other nations, and won the 2017 GTN Missionary Award for taking our training to 3 nations last year (Cameroon, Chad, and Central African Republic). This year he has taken our training to Equatorial Guinea and Sao Tome. Pastor Esambe is married and has 6 children.

The Rest of the Story...

In my September blog on God's Invisible Hand I shared the

story of how a pastor and head of a Bible College in Kenya, Dr. David Evans, had received a copy of our Management for Church Leaders training from an American named Blake and had been using it to teach our training. Since I did not know who this Blake person was I asked Dr. Ev-



ans for his email address, which he was able to provide.

I was able to contact him and it turns out he is a Missions Pastor at a church in Portland, Texas. He got a copy of our MCL training from our website and wanted to take it to Kenya to teach others. Dr. Evans happened to be one of the people he taught there.

I do not believe in the old adage that God works in mysterious ways. Instead, I believe he works in ways that fulfill His purposes. They are not mysterious, they are divine! God purposefully put our training into the hands of a Texas Pastor who believed it was worth sharing in Kenya. And God led a Kenya Bible College Director to attend his training and then share it as well. It is not a mystery and it is not a miracle. It's just how our awesome God works each and every day to accomplish His purposes!

MCL Trainer - Pastor Joshua Nguyen

Pastor Joshua Nguyen is our MCL Trainer in Vietnam and



also the Executive Director of Seed Global Consultancy which provides leadership & management training for business leaders. I was initially referred to him in 2015 and when he saw our MCL material he immediately invited me to come to Ho Chi Min City and Hanoi, Vietnam to teach it in 2016.

I then met Joshua for the first time at the Global Proclamation Congress for Pastoral Trainers (GPro) in Bangkok, Thailand in June of 2016, 2 months before our planned training. Neither one of us knew the other would be attending and we bumped into each other in the lunch line on the very first day of the conference. We recognized each other through the photos we had shared via email. That was quite remarkable because there were 3,000 people at the event!

Joshua joined our Global Trainer Network (GTN) and has since trained in Vietnam as well as **Laos** earlier this year. He is also intending on taking our training to **Malaysia**. Joshua is married with two teenage children and lives in Ho Chi Min City (*formerly Saigon*).


Prayer Requests


