A Biblical Response to the Corona Virus Pandemic

We are in the midst of worldwide pandemic due to the outbreak of a new form of the corona virus. It is causing many deaths and a shutdown of economic activity that threatens the jobs, income and survival of people and businesses all over the world. While we listen to disease experts and allow government leaders to make decisions on how we should respond, we sometimes assume that they have the knowledge to act wisely. But the truth is that they don't have the kind of specific knowledge needed to effectively combat the virus. As a result, decisions are made based upon our history with other viruses, inadequate data, and best guesses. And there is also no shortage of media pundits, scientists and others all sharing their thoughts and beliefs on social media on all sides of the issue. Consequently, the public is confused about what to believe. I know I am.

So what should we do when we have questions that do not have factual or adequate information upon which we can make decisions?

For Christians, we must turn to God and His Word for guidance. I believe the Bible gives us 4 ways that we can respond:

- 1. Get more facts. Obviously we need more factual information about the virus and its impact. We can't rely on inaccurate models, historical data and general assumptions. Proverbs 10:14 says, "Wise men store up knowledge." We are learning more about the virus every day, and we need to continue to test people and study the data so that we have more facts to make better decisions. But we also need to gather the facts ourselves. Don't just read one article or listen to one video but explore a variety of sources to become better informed.
- 2. **Be prudent**. All decisions have consequences so we must determine what we actually know and do not know. We must consider the benefits and risks of our decisions based upon the facts we know. **Proverbs 13:16** says that "*Every prudent man acts out of knowledge."* That means we must be cautious not to act universally or hastily if the knowledge is not sufficient to justify a decision that could harm more than it helps.
- 3. <u>Be humble</u>. We, as well as our leading scientists and government leaders, must have the humility to recognize that we don't know everything. We are not God and do not have perfect knowledge. We must look to Him and His Word for guidance. **Psalm 25:8-9** says, "Good and upright is the Lord; therefore he instructs sinners in his ways. He guides the humble in what is right and teaches them his ways." If we turn to God, He will provide the wisdom to guide us in our decisions.
- 4. <u>Be patient</u>. Because more time is needed to gather the facts, we need to be patient and allow our leaders to do that. In the meantime, we must pray for them to act wisely and prudently on our behalf. The Bible says in **Proverbs 15:18** that "A hot-tempered man stirs up dissension, but a patient mans calms a quarrel." So we must also exercise patience to bring peace and calm to our nation. Anger or conflict only serves Satan and his desire to distract us from God and combating the virus.

Let us strive for the facts and turn to God and His Word and prudently, humbly and patiently pray for His wisdom and guidance to help us respond and survive this pandemic.

Global MCL Training

Although much of our global training was restricted in April & May, here are a few highlights of the training that took place in the past 3 months:

- 1. Pastor Darwin Pangaribuan from Indonesia trained 14 church leaders in the city of Bandar Lampung.
- 2. **Pastor Jasper Goka** from **Ghana** trained 40 pastors and church leaders in the town of **Nzema**.
- 3. Pastor Ciza Sylvestre from Burundi trained 25 pastors and leaders in the city of Kanyosha.
- 4. Pastor Kiyingi Emmy from Uganda trained 60 pastors and leaders in the town of Lukaya.
- 5. One of our new MCL Trainers, **Bishop Chebon Eriama** from western **Kenya**, started training 24 pastors and church leaders in the towns of **Kumaet** and **Malakisi** in March (*photo below*).
- 6. Our newest MCL Trainer, **Dr. Fred Macharia** from **Nairobi**, **Kenya**, started training 9 pastors at his Theological College in **Nairobi** in March.
- 7. **Pastor Rajendra Sundas** from **Nepal** trained 50 pastors and church leaders in **Rasuwa** in April (photo below).
- 8. Pastor Ciza Sylvestre from Burundi trained 25 pastors and leaders in the town of Gatunguru.
- 9. **Pastor Jasper Goka** from **Ghana** trained 40 pastors and church leaders in the town of **Sekondi** in May.
- 10. **Pastor Kiyingi Emmy** from **Uganda** was also able to train two groups in May. He trained a group of 6 pastors at a home in **Setta** and he also trained 20 pastors and church leaders in the town of **Namayiba**.




- Dr. Fred Macharia, Professor at the International Faith Theological College in Nairobi, Kenya, joined our global trainer network.
