# Headed to Cape Town!



Barry is headed to Cape Town, South Africa next week to train 70 pastors and church leaders on our Management for Church Leaders training. Joining him to help train will be Kevin Elseroad, pastor of our home church in Georgia. Our host in Cape Town is Pastor Tosomba Lokombekombe and his Embassy of Christ Kingdom For All Nations church. Barry met Tosomba at the GPro II conference in Panama last November.

South Africa is a nation that needs our training. So, this is a very strategic opportunity for us to not only conduct an MCL training conference there, but to also train those at the conference to teach our training to others in this nation in the future.

Please pray for this conference, our safe travel, and that God would use it to produce fruit for His Kingdom in South Africa!

## A Return to China



I taught our Management for Church Leaders training in Shanghai & Beijing China back in May of 2015. We had two great conferences, but we have had no active training there since then. Over the past few years I have been working with Erik Burklin of China Partner about teaching our Management for Church Leaders training to their network of registered churches and seminaries throughout China. We have been discussing a possible training trip for 2025 now that China has reopened after Covid. Recently, Erik invited me to go to China this October to attend a symposium on the ministry needs of China.

I have registered for that symposium and am in the process of making plans to attend that conference in Shanghai. I will also be meeting several of China Partner's contacts and seminaries in Nanjing and Beijing while there as well. This will be a wonderful opportunity for me to educate myself on the specific training needs they have and to also meet the people who will likely host my training next year.

Please pray for my preparations for this trip, safe travel, and for the Lord to speak to me on how best to teach our MCL training in China when I go there next year for that purpose.

# **Global Training Summary**



Over the past three months our global trainer network has been very active in teaching our various training courses. Here are the summaries for each of the past 3 months:

Our global trainer network had a busy June with 17

conferences being held in the nations of Botswana, Uganda, Kenya, Senegal, Togo, DRC, Tanzania, Philippines, India, Nepal, Pakistan and Ukraine (see photo at right). A total of



758 pastors and church leaders were trained.

July was supposed to be a slow month for our training. Instead, there were 14 training conferences held where



our global trainers trained a total of 470 pastors and church leaders via those 14 conferences in 7 nations, including Uganda, Kenya, Burundi, Tanzania, Zambia, Bangladesh and

the Philippines. The photo above is from the training in Malakisi, Kenya by Pastor Chebon Eriama. Two of our newest MCL Trainers, Eric Wambua and David Njuguna from Kenya, both taught their very first MCL training in July!

Our global trainer network had another successful month of training in August. They conducted 11 train-

ing conferences in the nations of Uganda, Tanzania, Togo, India, Pakistan, Nepal, and the Ukraine. They trained a total of 655 pastors,



church leaders, and children's ministry leaders, bringing our total for the year through August to 5,383! The photo above is from the training in **Pakistan** taught by **Hamid Iqbal**. We also added another global trainer in August. Our newest MCL Trainer is **Pastor Kra Konan** from **Abidjan, Ivory Coast**.

We continue to train at a pace, that will help us to surpass our annual goal of 8,000 pastors and church leaders trained this year. Praise the Lord!

#### **New Courses Draw Interest!**



Last year we introduced 3 new self-training books to our list of training resources. Since their introduction in 2023, there have been 59 requests for our MCL #2 book, 58 requests for our DCL book, and 48 requests for our Children's Ministry book. #### When is a church not His Church?

The Christian Church today hardly resembles the one that Jesus' disciples started 2,000 years ago. His Church today is divided and fragmented. So, when is a church not His Church? Let me share 6 ways that this happens.

- 1. When a church accepts cultural values over Biblical teaching. When a church deviates from God's Word and accepts cultural values or practices that do not conform to Biblical teaching, they are no longer being His Church. These churches are man-focused instead of God-focused and are no longer able to effectively make disciples for Jesus Christ.
- 2. When a church is focused on outward results instead of inward transformation. Too often churches present their accomplishments instead of Jesus or the gospel to attract non-believers to attend their church or ministries. When churches are focused on outward results instead of inward transformation, they cease to function as His Church was designed to function.
- 3. When a church prefers organizational efficiency over spiritual impact. There are many churches that strive for operational efficiency. And while the church may run like a well-oiled machine, their ministry may have little or no spiritual impact on those who slide in and out of church with no contact or engagement with anyone. When this happens, a church is not His Church as it was intended to be.
- 4. When a church seeks political solutions instead of discipleship. When Jesus came to the earth, He never sought political power or a human kingship. Therefore, the role of His Church is to influence and change the hearts of mankind and not to leverage the government to enforce Biblical obedience.
- 5. When a church is financially stable but spiritually bankrupt. The Church was never called to be financially solid and always in the black. The Church is called to be "Salt & Light" (Matthew 5) and to serve others in Jesus' name while trusting in God for the financial provision needed to accomplish His purpose.
- 6. When a church lacks a missional emphasis. When a church ceases to find ways to reach the world with the good news of Jesus, it is no longer acting like His Church.
